# **ACCESSORY STRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES**

# Zoning approval is required for all accessory structures. Accessory structures fall into one of the following categories:

- <u>Detached accessory structures</u>: storage buildings, detached garages, carports, sheds, gazebos, workshops, similar structures.
- <u>Marine accessory structures</u>: boathouses over water, piers, docks, boat ramps, similar structures.
- Pool accessory structures: pool houses, cabanas.



## To apply for zoning approval for an accessory structure, the following is required:

- For residentially-zoned properties, in addition to the principal structure, one (1) detached accessory structure and one (1) pool accessory structure are allowed.
- There is no restriction on the number of marine accessory structures.
- The applicant must provide a site plan showing all dimensions and square footage for the structure, setbacks to the property lines, the height and number of stories, and the proposed use of the structure.
- A building permit is required. The site plan and all pertinent zoning information must be submitted with the building permit.

### Accessory structures are subject to the provisions of Section 5.04 and Section 5.06 of the Zoning Ordinance:

#### **LOCATION ON THE LOT:**

- Permitted in the side or rear yard.
- May be permitted in front yard if the distance between the accessory structure and the required front setback line is a minimum of 100 feet.

## **MAXIMUM AREA:**

- Cannot exceed 30% of the yard area in which the structure is located <u>or</u> 75% of the square footage of the principal structure, whichever is less.
- Applies to detached accessory structures and pool accessory structures.
- Does not apply to marine accessory structures.

#### **MAXIMUM HEIGHT:**

- Maximum height is 20 feet.
- Applies to detached accessory structures and pool accessory structures.
- Does not apply to marine accessory structures.

#### **SETBACKS:**

- For accessory structures with a footprint area equal to or less than 100 square feet:
  - o Rear setback is 5 feet.
  - Side setbacks are 5 feet.
  - o Five-foot separation from the principal structure.
- For accessory structures with a footprint area exceeding 100 square feet and equal to or less than 400 square feet:
  - Rear setback is 10 feet.
  - o Side setbacks are 10 feet.
  - Five-foot separation from the principal structure.
- For accessory structures with a footprint area exceeding 400 square feet.
  - Rear setback is 20 feet.
  - o Side setbacks are 10 feet.
  - Five-foot separation from the principal structure.
- For accessory structures with a height exceeding 10 feet regardless of the footprint area:
  - o Rear setback is 20 feet.
  - o Side setbacks are 10 feet.
  - o Five-foot separation from the principal structure.
- Applies to the combined footprint area of the detached accessory structure and pool accessory structure.
- Does not apply to marine accessory structures.

#### TIME OF CONSTRUCTION:

- No accessory structure can be constructed on a lot until the building permit for the principal structure to which it is an accessory has been acquired.

ACCESSORY STRUCTURES CANNOT BE USED AS A DWELLING AND MAY NOT BE USED AS PART OF A HOME BUSINESS OR HOME OCCUPATION.
